The trust aims to build a school in the small village of Yamcha, on the banks of the Godavari River near Basar, Andhra Pradesh.


The current school is seriously lacking in facilities and a new one is urgently required by the local community. In order to build the school, funds and support, sponsorships etc. are being gathered.



Activities

In Detail:

Annadhanam – Anyone who comes to the Ashram is provided with food and shelter everyday. It has also been a practice every year that our Ashram performs Annadhanam at Sabari Mala for all the pilgrims who travel from all over India to visit Lord Ayappa's temple.

Children's Home – The Ashram is the home for many children from poor and remote villages. They are provided with education, food, shelter and clothing.

Free education – This privilege will be provided to all children despite of their lack of economic and social difficulties. We are in the process of building schools and technical institutions.

Old Age Homes – Our Ashram provides old age homes to make the elderly feel comfortable.

Medical Assistance – Swamiji is organising to establish hospitals, and medical camps, where all medical facilities are absolutely free of cost.
